Obs and Gynae


ANDU, ward reviews, Post op reviews, Gynae assessment



Myth busting


Most doctors have not worked with PAs...yet Fear of the unknown...

In general PAs are **very useful**, provide continuity, understand how the department works and can assist with logistical problems. In general **very capable** clinically, taking pressure off the rest of the team"


